A major part of this program will be to evaluate the immunogenicity of these new vaccines in children and adults. One of the major obstacles to the development of effective and safe vaccines is the lack of standard methods to measure immune responses. Most vaccine studies currently involve measuring antibody responses or complement-mediated lysis using guinea pig complement. These systems are limited because they are insensitive to most antigens, and they do not measure T cell responses, which are important for protective immunity. T cell responses are also important for controlling reactivation of latent viruses that persist for life. The development of new tests for vaccine evaluation is crucial for several reasons. First, the ability to measure immune responses and to correlate them with protective immunity will help to predict the efficacy of vaccines in the field. Second, new test systems will help to define the requirements for immune memory and protective immunity. Finally, new assays may provide useful tools for identifying the immunologic markers of protective immunity. We propose to develop new test systems that measure immune responses in animal models, and to evaluate the use of these systems in vaccine studies. The systems that we will investigate include: T cell proliferative responses, T cell cytotoxicity, the induction of interferon, and antigen-specific CTLQ.
